

24-Story, 55-Unit Mixed-Use Tower Tops Out at 50 West 30th Street, NoMad

onstruction has topped out on The NOMA, a 24-story, 55-unit mixed-usetower, located at 50 West 30th Street on the corner of Sixth Avenue, in NoMad. YIMBY has exclusive photos of the topped-out structure. The latest building permits

indicate the project encompasses 105,973 square feet and rises 315 feet to the top of

the parapet.

There will be 10,363 square feet of commercial-retail space across the ground, second, and cellar floors, followed by 55 residentialunits throughout the third through 24th floors. The apartments will be condominiums, averaging 1,320 square feet apiece, and will range from one- to three-bedroom configurations.

Residential amenities will include storage for 30 bicycles in the cellar, as well as a community room and outdoor terrace on the fifth floor. The terrace will have landscaping, seating, and a dining area.
